2. CONFIRM THE PREVIOUS COUNCIL MINUTES.

A. the Head of Customers & Education Support of Denbighshire County Council reported the following regarding Ysgol Garreg Emlyn:-

1. On the 24th February 2015 the County secured a £2.8million for the project as the business case was approved and included in the Council's capital plan.
