

MINUTES OF THE CLOCAENOG COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 17TH MARCH 2015 IN THE CHURCH HALL CLOCAENOG AT 7.30 P.M.

2. CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS COUNCIL MEETINGS.

Members confirmed the minutes of the previous Council meetings held on 20th January and 17th February 2015 as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

The Highways Department of Denbighshire County Council reported on the following:-
