

MINUTES OF THE CLOCAENOG COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 18TH NOVEMBER 2014 IN THE CHURCH HALL, CLOCAENOG AT 7.30 P.M.

2. CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS COUNCIL MEETING.

Members confirmed the minutes of the 16th September 2014 minutes as a true record and signed by the Chairman.

3. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES.
