3. CONFIRM MINUTES 13<sup>TH</sup> JULY AND 31<sup>ST</sup> AUGUST 2016 MEETINGS.

4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES.

A. the Public Services Ombudsman for Wales has closed the file on the complaint made against the Clocaenog Community Council on the basis of the action which has been taken to resolve the matter.

B. Members noted the letter received from Mr Andrew Hilton of Glan Aber, Clocaenog regarding the highway boundary.

C. Denbighshire County Council confirmed that any highway verge planning requires a licence under Section 142 of the Highways Act 1980.
