

MINUTES OF THE CLOCAENOG COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2017 IN THE CHURCH HALL, CLOCAENOG AT 7.30 P.M.

3. CONFIRM THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS COUNCIL MEETING.

A. the Clerk still awaits a full reply from Denbighshire County Council regarding a more informative “Unsuitable for Large Vehicles” signage opposite Bryn Ffynnon (Clocaenog) highway junction.
